



Are You Struggling with Uncomfortable Drafts or High BGE Bills?

Retrofit Baltimore just received a grant from the Maryland Energy Administration (MEA) that will enable them to subsidize the cost of a home energy retrofit for moderate income households. An energy retrofit is a series of custom energy-saving home improvements, usually involving sealing air leaks and installing insulation. A retrofit makes your home safer, more comfortable, and more affordable. Retrofit Baltimore is a program of the nonprofit Civic Works- not an energy company. All of the work is performed by vetted contractors that have also committed to creating family-sustaining careers for underserved Baltimoreans.

Benefits of a Home Energy Retrofit:

Safety: Air sealing will help block out pests and pollutants, improving your indoor air quality.

Comfort: A retrofit eliminates uncomfortable drafts and variations in temperature, making your home more comfortable year-round.

Savings: A retrofit results in long-term savings on energy costs. Homeowners can lower the utility bills by an average of 20%.

You Could Qualify If:

You are a homeowner without a leaky basement or roof

Your income falls within the levels listed to the right

You can provide a copayment of \$100
